Position Summary

We are seeking a gifted and spiritually mature Worship Director to lead our congregation in Christ-centered, biblically faithful worship. Our worship style is blended — drawing from the rich heritage of classic hymnody alongside thoughtful contemporary praise music. The Worship Director will work closely with our pastor to select and provide appropriate music for Sunday Services that align with the preaching themes.

Key Responsibilities

- Plan and lead music and selected worship elements for Sunday morning services, coordinating with the Pastor to align worship with the sermon and the church calendar.
 - Lead and facilitate weekly rehearsals with the praise team, providing musical and spiritual direction.
 - Recruit, develop, and shepherd volunteer musicians and vocalists, fostering a team culture of prayer, humility, and excellence.
 - Lead worship for special services including Christmas, Easter, Good Friday, and other occasions as needed.
 - Manage worship-related administrative responsibilities, including CCLI song usage tracking and reporting.
 - Assist with worship presentation software (e.g., PowerPoint or ProPresenter) for song lyrics, call to worship, and service elements.

- Ability to work collaboratively and humbly with pastoral staff, elders, and church members.

Preferred Qualifications

- Formal musical and/or theological training.
 - Proficiency with worship presentation and audio/visual technology, including sound systems and live streaming.
 - Familiarity with worship in the Reformed (Protestant/Presbyterian) tradition.
